Commission staff notes that the Commission's policies on Internet traffic management practices (ITMP) have been set out in <u>Telecom Regulatory Policy 2009-657</u>, *Review of the Internet traffic management practices of Internet service providers*, 21 October 2009 (TRP 2009-657). Based on the allegations in your complaint, Commission staff considers that you have not provided any evidence that Barrett is in violation of TRP 2009-657.

In light of the above, Commission staff does not consider that your complaint requires further action.
