Slight modifications. Please prepare as a note to the Minister.

* I am delighted to tell you that today, my Government has introduced amendments to the Copyright Act.

* The bulk of these implement the various rights and protections found in the 1996 WIPO Internet treaties.

* We will be working hard to secure the Bill's passage through the House of Commons when Parliament resumes in 2008.

* Of course, we are a minority government and must depend on the support of opposition parties. We are working with them to bring them on board.

* In a minority, passage may require a willingness to accept amendments in committee. For my part, I would not accept amendments that would compromise our ability to join the treaties.
